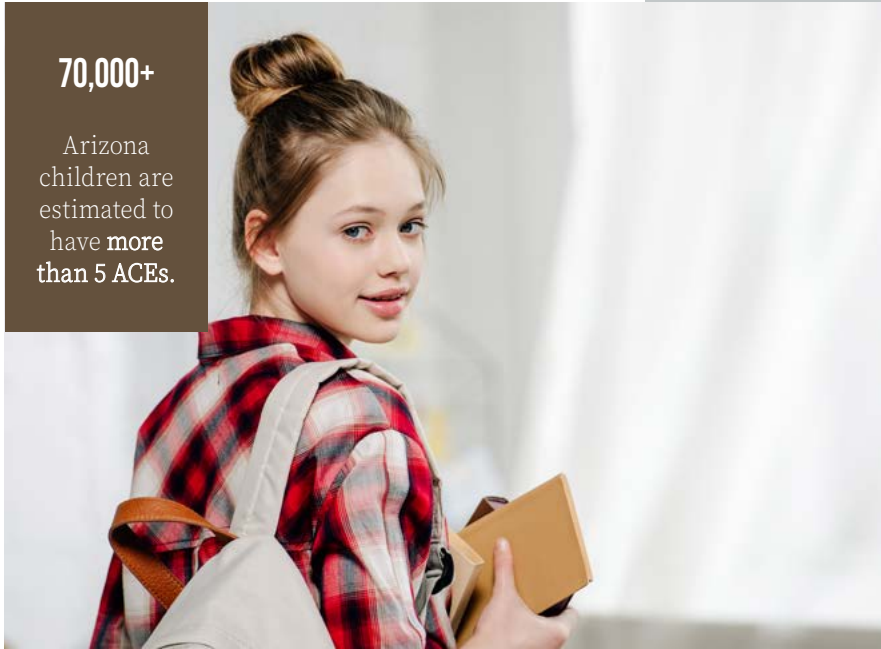

## 3 UNIQUE PROGRAMS

Find the right fit for your needs

In-person training sessions are held at sites for community organizations serving youth and families, or virtually online, as requested by leadership. All sessions are interactive and led by both a certified ACEs trainer and a Master’s-level Social Worker (MSW). Training curricula are designed by Arizona-based social workers, counselors, therapists and health professionals who understand the demographics, cultures and communities represented in our local organizations.

### COMMUNITY YOUTH ORGANIZATION PROGRAM

For Counselors & Staff of community youth organizations, youth from the community, and families from the community: **1 session; 4 hours total**

### ADMINISTRATOR’S PROGRAM

For Organization Administrators and Board leadership: **1 session; 1.5 hours total**

*\*may be done alone, but is required for community youth organization program*

### YOUTH ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM

For youth leaders with organizational & parental approval: **3 sessions; 3 hours total**

*\*may be added on with other training options*
